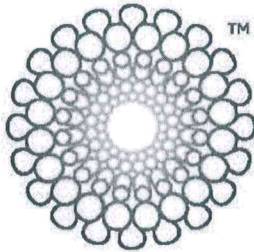

The registrant named above is informed that the National Liquor Authority, on behalf of the Minister of Trade and Industry, hereby imposes the following as conditions of registration in terms of section 13, or Item 4 of Schedule 1, of the Liquor Act, 2003, for the reasons set out in the attached covering letter.

1. The liquor product(s) to be distributed should comply with the definition provided in the Liquor Act 59 of 2003 and/or the definition of the Liquor Products Act 60 of 1989 as and when amended;
2. The distribution activities should be conducted from premises and at a location approved by the relevant local authority;
3. Liquor may only be distributed to registered persons/ entities or other licensees;
4. The registrant must not employ a person who has not attained the age of 16 unless the employee is undergoing training or learnership contemplated in section 16 of the Skill Development Act No. 97 of 1989;
5. The registrant must comply with Customs and Excise Duties Act No.91 of 1964;
6. The registrant must comply with all the provisions of the Liquor Act 59 of 2003 and/ or any other relevant law;
7. The registrant should provide the National Liquor Authority with a BEE compliance certificate annually;
8. The registrant should provide the National Liquor Authority with a Tax Clearance Certificate annually.
9. The registrant should provide the National Liquor Authority with proof of contribution to combating alcohol abuse annually.
10. The registrant should provide the National Liquor authority with the Police clearance Certificates for the directors in the entity annually.
